Subject: **ORIENTATION ON THE STANDARDIZED TEST ADMINISTRATION OF THE EARLY LANGUAGE LITERACY AND NUMERACY ASSESSMENT (ELLNA), NATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT TEST (NAT) AND ACCREDITATION & EQUIVALENCY (A & E) TEST**

Date: June 7, 2017

- The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA), shall administer the Early Language Literacy and Numeracy Assessment (ELLNA) to the incoming Grade 4 pupils of public schools, National Achievement Test (NAT) to the incoming **Grades 7 and 11** students of public and private schools, and Accreditation and Equivalency (A & E) Test for Alternative Learning System (ALS) learners.
- With these, the SGOD-Testing Unit of the Division of Iligan City shall conduct an **Orientation on the Standardized Test Administration of the ELLNA, NAT, and A & E Test** at the Division Conference Hall on the following schedules:

Public Elem. School Heads or School Testing Coordinators and District Guidance Coordinators/Designates	June 13, 2017 – 1:30 PM
Public, Private, MSU-IIT IDS Secondary School Heads or School Testing Coordinators and District Guidance Coordinators/Designates	June 15, 2017 – 8:30 AM
Education Program Supervisors in ALS, Education Program Specialists II in ALS and DALSC, District ALS Coordinators, ALS Mobile Teachers, and District Guidance Coordinators/Designates	June 15, 2017 – 1:30 PM

- Each school should submit on **June 19, 2017** to the Division Office the hard copy of the List of Examinees (30 examinees per room arranged alphabetically regardless of gender) with corresponding Room Examiners and Room Supervisors.
- For the assignments of Room Examiners, the ELLNA shall be district-based while for the NAT 7 & 11 and the A & E, the Division Office shall assign the Room Examiners ensuring that no teacher shall serve as examiner in his/her own school/learning center. There shall be one (1) Room Supervisor in every five (5) rooms with 30 examinees per room.
- School Heads are expected to recommend reliable, competent and experienced Room Examiners/Room Supervisors who will facilitate the examination.
- Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
