 - c. PowerPoint slides are required as visual aid for presentation. The presentation should not exceed 10 minutes. Presenters are also advised to provide their own laptops, tables, and other gadgets needed in the exhibit/presentation.
 - d. Reproduce 15 copies of the paper abstract for the audience who may get interested of your study.
 - e. Prepare a vertical poster layout of 48x36 inches size for the gallery/exhibit highlighting the following components:
